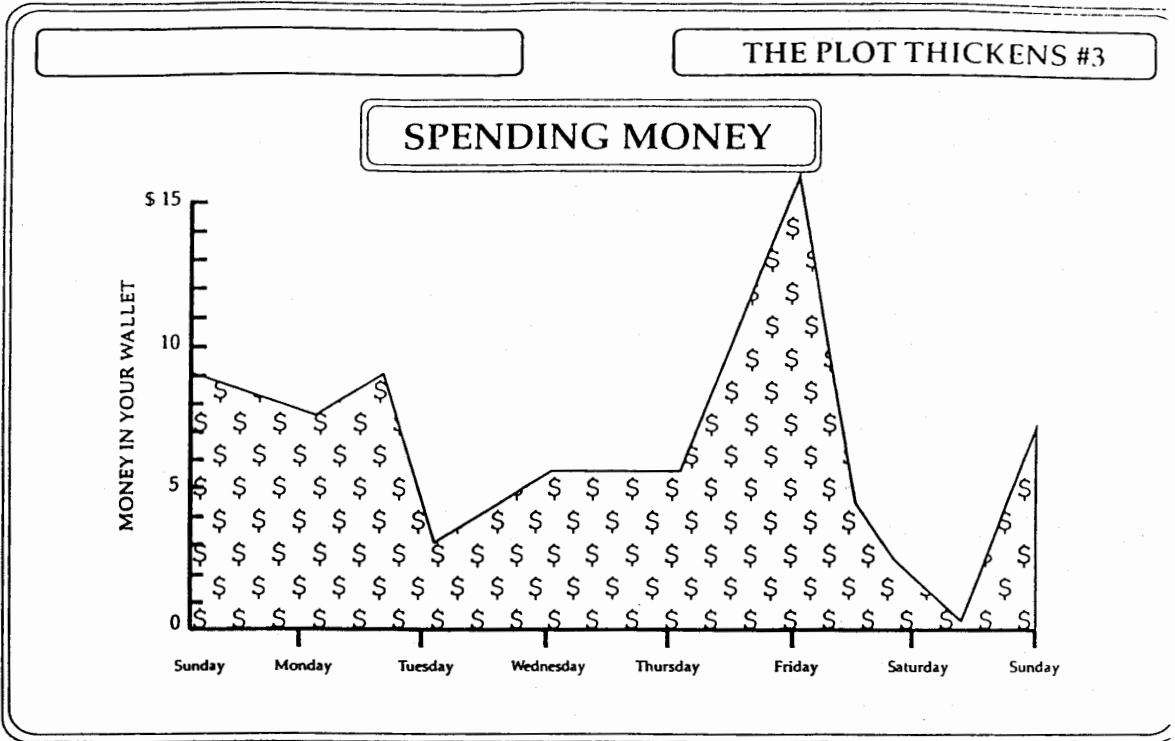
1. What is the most shoplifted book?

MISLEADING STATISTICS

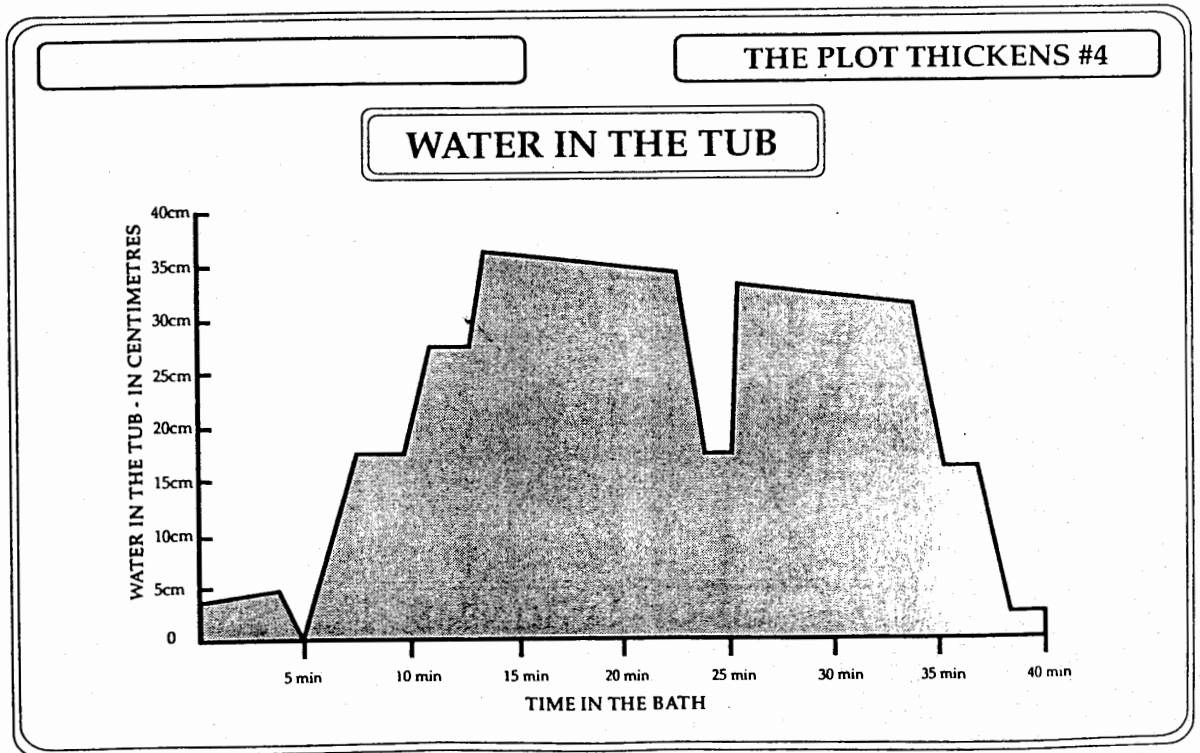
On a separate piece of paper write a few sentences on why you think that the following statistics are misleading. **THIS IS DUE TOMORROW.**

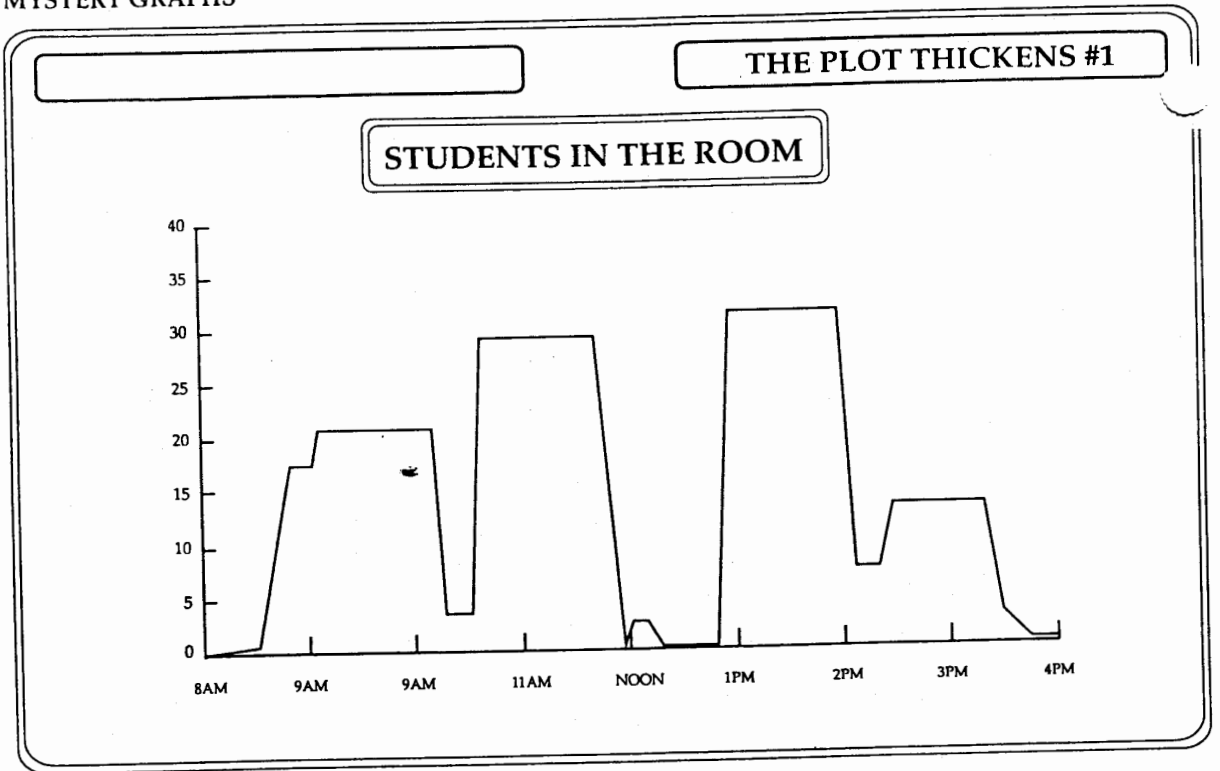
